## Junior High Camp

- Casual outdoor clothing
- Dressier outfit for the dance
- Sleeping bag or sheets and blanket
- Pillow
- Towels and toiletries
- Swimming suit
- Rain gear (just in case)
- Sweater or jacket
- Sunscreen and Insect repellent
- Sports equipment
- Flashlight
- Bible and Prayer book
- Musical instrument (if you play one—please bring it!)
- Notebook and pens, pencils
- Money for snack bar (\$10 Maximum)

## You Should Know:

- Possession of drugs, alcohol or weapons will be grounds for immediate dismissal.
- Smoking is not permitted.
- Dangerous or illegal behavior will get you sent home.
- Music players (tape/cd/mp3 etc) are permitted only in the cabins. Please bring headphones
- No one will be permitted to stay without a completed health form and conference contract.

## THIS IS FOR PARENTS!:

- The Registration and Health forms must be completed in full and signed. No child will be allowed to stay without these forms. **Dates must be included for all immunizations!**
- Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Sign-in will take place between 3-5 pm on Sunday, August 12. Dinner will be served that evening.
